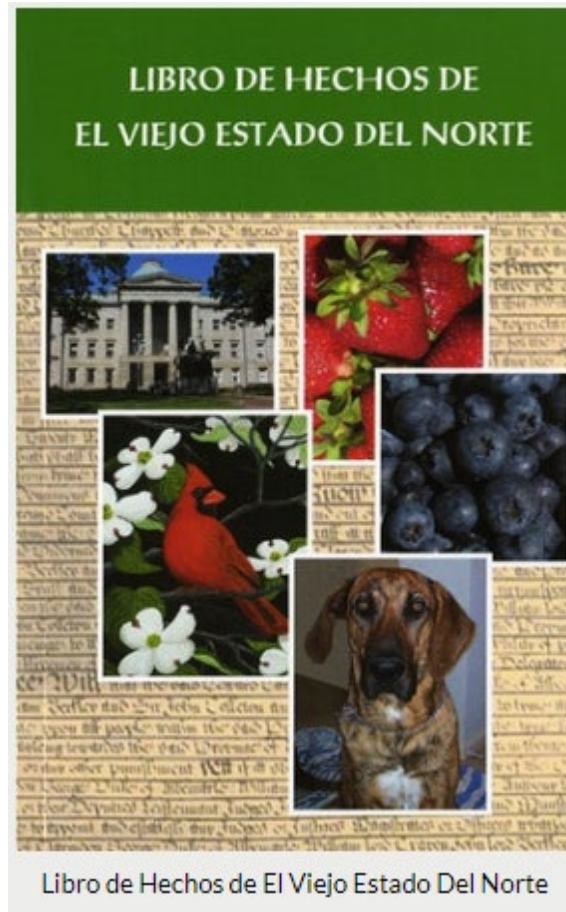

La Asamblea General de 1979 adoptó la tortuga como el reptil del estado, designando la tortuga de caja del este (*Terrapene carolina*) como el emblema que representa las tortugas que habitan en Carolina del Norte (G.S. 145-9).

La tortuga de caja del este es la especie de tortugas terrestre norteamericana nativa del sur de las montañas Apalaches. Mayormente viven cerca o en los bosques y comen una variedad de plantas y animales como bayas, hongos, lapas e insectos. La tortuga no muerde cuando la cargan, pero recoge sus patas, cabeza y cola cerrando su caparazón bien apretado. La tortuga hembra pone de tres a seis huevos en junio o julio en un hoyo que hace con sus patas posteriores. Entonces los cubre con tierra, quedándose ahí hasta que salen del caparazón dos o tres meses más tarde. Las tortugas adultas miden de cinco a seis pies de largo y viven silvestres por aproximadamente cuarenta años.

COVID-19 RESPONSE MINI-GRANTS

- Deadline: June 1
- Awarded \$227,000 since April 22
 - 50 Public libraries
 - 34 Community College libraries
 - 18 NCICU libraries
 - 7 UNC libraries

Public Law 116-136 provides that this funding, available until September 30, 2021, is for the following purposes:

- To prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus, including
- To expand digital network access, purchase internet accessible devices, and provide technical support services

- Two competitive grants based on our current structure
 - EZ-up to \$10,000 for devices, hotspots, etc.
 - Project-up to \$75,000 for partner-based collaborative work around digital inclusion

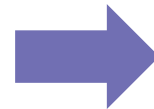

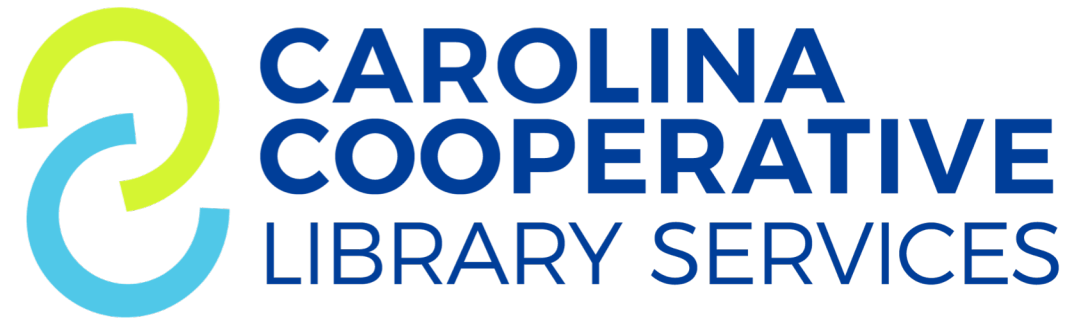

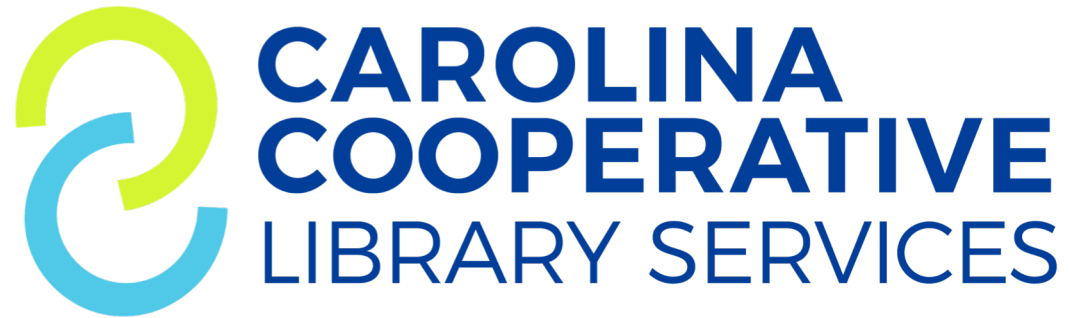
